Most Pennsylvania municipal governments and local school districts impose a low-rate earned income tax.

Effective July 1, 2026, the earned income tax (EIT) rate is 1% for residents of Springfield Township. The Springfield School District rate is 0% for a combined total EIT of 1%.

A 1% “non-resident” EIT also applies to employees who commute to work in Springfield Township. If the rates for the resident jurisdiction (where the employee lives) and workplace jurisdiction (where the employee works) differ, employers must withhold at the higher of the two rates.

Your business must withhold from payroll and report employee EIT to Keystone in compliance with Pennsylvania law. Quarterly payroll withholding returns and payments are due within 30 days after the close of each calendar quarter. *Make your payment by the quarterly due date to avoid statutory penalty, interest and Act 192 costs.*
