

## Earned Income Tax

**Springfield Township**

Effective July 1, 2026, the earned income tax (EIT) rate is 1% for residents of Springfield Township. The Springfield School District rate is 0%, for a combined EIT of 1%. The EIT is levied on earned income and net profits, including wages, salaries, commissions and other compensation. Many residents already pay the tax in their employer's jurisdiction, but now the tax revenue will remain in their home community.

### ***If you are an Employee***

Your employer is required by law to withhold the tax due from payroll. To avoid tax filing issues:

- provide a copy of this letter to your employer to ensure that the EIT withholding rate is being withheld and reported correctly.
- review your pay stubs to verify that your employer is withholding the tax at the correct rate.

### ***If you are Self-Employed or Employed Outside of Pennsylvania***

If you are self-employed, have earnings reported on Form 1099, or your employer is not withholding your local tax, you must report the tax quarterly; access [efile.KeystoneCollects.com](http://efile.KeystoneCollects.com). ### ***Local Earned Income Tax Annual Final Return Form and Instructions***

Pennsylvania law requires residents with earned income or net profits to file an annual local earned income tax return online or by mail on or before next April 15. Even if you have employer withholding, you must still file a tax return. Tax forms and filing instructions will be sent to taxpayers via mail later this year.
